Boston – Eloine D. (Jachimowicz) Vieira, 82, died Friday, February 5, 2021 at Massachusetts General Hospital. She was the wife of Alvin Vieira.

Born in New Bedford, daughter of the late Alexander and Stella (Wiecek) Jachimowicz, she lived in Fairhaven since 1961. She was a member of St. Joseph's Church, Fairhaven.

Eloine traveled the world extensively, and loved to read, play golf and bridge, spend time with her husband and children at Hilton Head Island, SC, as well as fun times with her grandchildren.

Energetic and dynamic, Eloine was an educator devoted to her students; a professor who inspired ordinary people to achieve extraordinary things.

Eloine was a member and former President of the Massachusetts Business Educators Assoc., where she was voted Business Educator of the Year in 1998. She was also a member of the Eastern Business Education Assoc., the Polish Women's Business and Professional Club, Southcoast Wise Investment Club, and volunteer usher at the Zeiterion.
